General Supplies:

- 1 assignment book, ***which was purchased at registration***
- 5 red ink-ball point stick pens (no erasable or pens with retractable points)
- 10 blue/ black ink ball-point stick pens (no erasable or pens with retractable points)
- 12 #2 lead pencils (Mechanical pencils are acceptable)
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 2 scotch tape
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 scissors
- 1 stapler with a supply of staples
- 1 a supply of pencil erasers
- 1 personal pencil sharpener
- 3 packages of 300 count college rule binder paper
- 1 Bible, St. Joseph's edition
- 4 notebooks (One for each subject, these will need to be replenished during the school year)
- 1 Lab book (Computation Notebook 11 $\frac{3}{4}$ " X 9 $\frac{1}{4}$ ", 75 sheets – 150 pages 4x4 Quad Ruled, 20# Premium Green Paper) ***You can reuse last year's notebook for upcoming year.***
- 1 3 ring binder- 1' binding with 2 packages of dividers (for Language Arts)
- 1 binder or folders (to keep papers neat and tidy)
- 1 desk top dictionary
- 1 book bag
- 5 book covers (no stick on covers)
- 1 Scientific calculator (need not be expensive)
- 1 ruler, protractor, and compass
- 1 hole punch
- 3 Composition bound notebook (i.e. black and white w/sewn binding)
- 1 SD/MS/MMC/MS Pro Memory Card or USB 2.0 Flash Memory (A memory stick with no less than 64 Megabytes of memory)

P.E. Uniform:

- 1 pair of plain dark blue/ navy shorts for P.E. (You will be required to dress out for P.E.)
- 1 plain white tee-shirt for (School uniform shirt, Saints t-shirt is acceptable)
- 1 pair of tennis shoes (If tennis shoes are not worn as part of the uniform)
